## Why participate in the Scottish Week?

## How does the Scottish Week work?

- Scottish week takes place immediately following the Horu Trophy in Zermatt
- There are **three** different tournaments held over the five day period
  - Each tournament consists of **three** 7-end games
  - For each tournament, **mixed** Scottish and Swiss teams are assembled taking into account player's position preferences
  - Winners are determined based upon Points (2, 1, 0), Ends, and Stones
- Players can choose to participate in one, two, or all three tournaments
  - Cost is 30 CHF per tournament
